

## High School Ministry | 2024–2025 Calendar

**KOINONIA** (the Greek word for community) is the heart of our high school ministry. We split Sunday evenings in half—engaging in large group (including fellowship, Scripture-based teaching, and student-led worship) and small group (grade/gender-based groups built for discussion and support) gatherings. Koinonia begins in September and runs most Sunday evenings through the middle of May.

**WHEN** | Sundays | 7:00–8:45 p.m.

**CONFIRMATION** | Our mentor-based confirmation adventure is the perfect inroad for all freshman joining the Koinonia community. Students are carefully placed into small mentor groups for the entire first semester. These groups meet during the second half of each Koinonia to walk through the basics of faith and continuing the journey of making their faith their own.

**WHEN** | Sundays | 7:00–8:45 p.m.

**MOSAIC** | Mosaic is our student leadership team made up of small group “tiles” that are built around the God-given spiritual gifts that each of us are given. All students who wish to grow in their faith and are ready to take the next step into service and leadership development are invited to join.

**WHEN** | Wednesdays | 7:00–8:30 p.m.

**FALL RETREAT** | Fall Sabbath is a weekend retreat at Covenant Harbor in Lake Geneva, Wisconsin that offers students a time to recalibrate amidst their busy schedules of school and extra-curriculars. This weekend is often the highlight of our students’ years as they can move away from the many distractions of their weekly lives and fully focus on their relationship with Christ.
